2.2 Describe a range of key job roles and responsibilities in the film industry

Research 5 different roles in a film production and summarise the responsibilities and qualities needed to carry out each role.

1	Director A director brings the vision of the film to reality by directing how each department should act in order to produce what the director is visualising. A director needs: • Creativity • Communication • Leadership qualities • A knowledge of how each department works
2	Editor An editor will constantly monitor for mistakes in visual and sound recordings throughout production. Then will put it all together creating the directors cut An editor needs: • Sharp eye • Advanced editing software knowledge • Communication • Creative understanding.

3	Sound editor The sound editor will prepare all recorded sounds, sound effects and music for the final mix. They will also make sure any unwanted sounds are omitted. A sound editor needs: • Ears • Basic musical understanding • Advanced audio processing understanding
4	Camera Operator A camera operator records the scene with visual direction from the director and art director. A camera operator needs: • Advanced camera understanding • Spatial awareness • Creative understanding
5	Actor An actor portrays a given character that creates the narrative of a story. An actor can work in both film and theatre. An actor needs: • Creativity • Acting skills • Storytelling techniques
